An Introduction to Cal-Bridge (for students and faculty)

Abstract: Cal-Bridge is a scholarship program that supports CSU students interested in pursuing a PhD in Physics and Astronomy, Computer Science, or any of the Mathematical Sciences (pure, applied, statistics, math ed, etc).

In this presentation, Oscar Vega (CSU Co-Director of Cal-Bridge Math) will introduce to students and faculty what Cal-Bridge does, how it does it, who should apply, and what kinds of support it offers (besides scholarship money). Also, Cal-Bridge requires a faculty member at the campus the scholar attends to serve as their mentor. Hence, faculty interest in being a Cal-Bridge mentor is crucial for an applicant to be eligible for funding.

Scholarships are for up to \$15,000 per year for up to two years. Rising Juniors at a CSU, interested in getting a PhD in Physics and Astronomy, Computer Science, or any of the Mathematical Sciences, are encouraged to apply, deadline April 10th.
